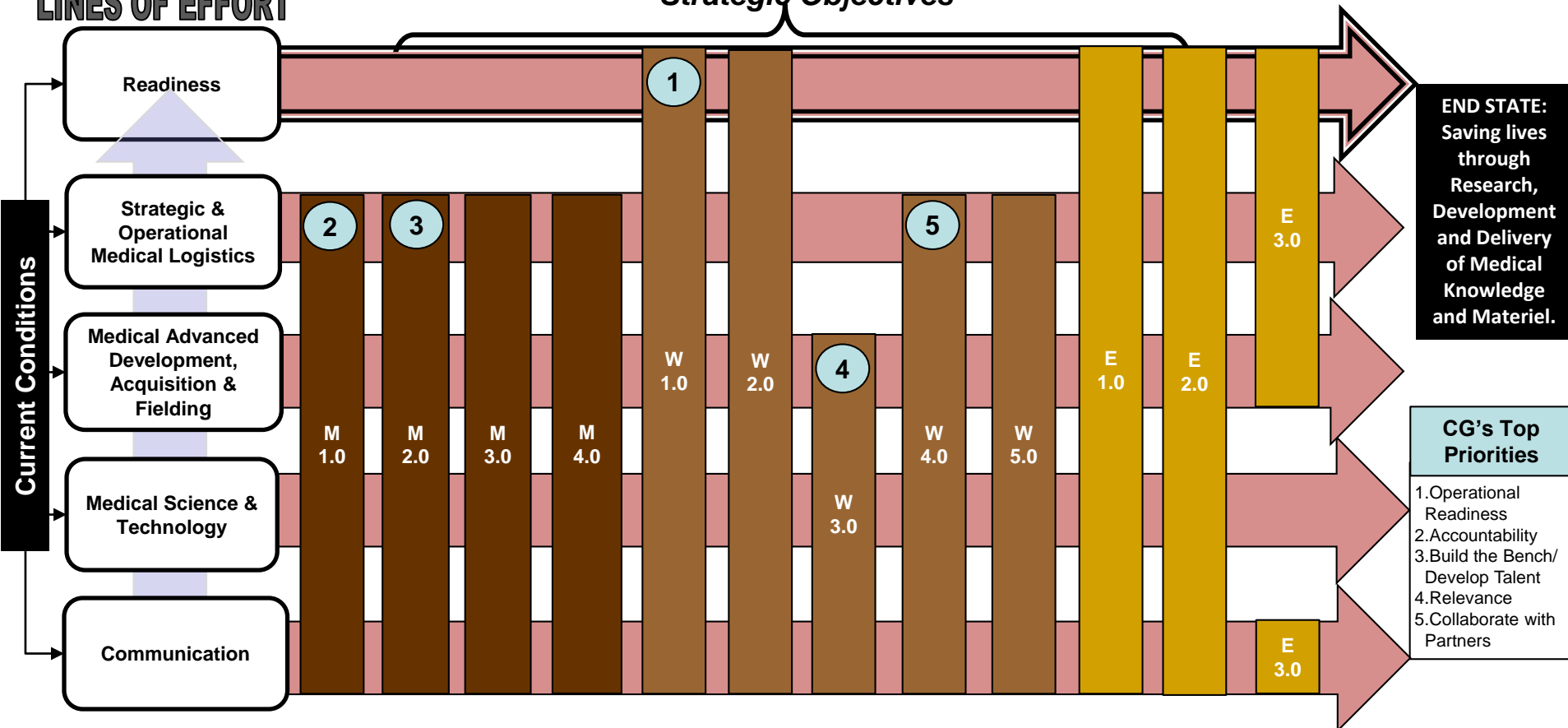


# US Army Medical Research and Materiel Command – Operational Approach
